


# BEAUTY AND THE BEAST





## SYNOPSIS:

Our modern day take on “Beauty and the Beast” takes place in Hollywood and London. Belle lives with her father, Maurice, and her stepmother, who is only concerned about superficial appearances. Her father’s aeroplane crashes on a business trip and he stays the night in the Beast’s mansion in the Hollywood Hills. This intrusion angers the Beast and he decides to hold Maurice hostage and later agrees to a trade and takes Belle instead.

Belle soon discovers that the Beast is not as bad nor as evil as he first seemed. He had been a bully at school and was punished and deformed by a witch. Belle realises that we should never judge a person by their appearance and begins to befriend the Beast and inspires him to read.

Belle and the Beast realise that what is on the outside is not what really counts, but the person that is hidden beneath.

## Worksheet 1: Planes And Pilots

As we know, Belle wants to be a pilot. She loves airplanes and flying.

Children from **C.I.** can colour the aeroplane and Belle, those from **C.M.** and **C.S.**, can label the different parts of the aeroplane as well as the equipment every pilot needs to fly.

You can also ask your students what their dream jobs are. Encourage them to explain why.

## Worksheet 2: Means Of Transport

The aeroplane is an exciting way to travel, and it is definitely Belle's favourite!

Children can use the English language to learn about the different ways to travel. Students from **C.I.** can look at the pictures and repeat the names and play a mime game afterwards. They could also draw and colour their favourite ones.

Students from **C.M.** and **C.S.** can answer the questions by playing a guessing game. At the end, they can draw their favourite transport and personalise it. You can then display your students' drawings in the classroom.

**Key: 1-bicycle, 2-boat, 3-bus, 4-rocket, 5-car, 6-motorbike.**

## Worksheet 3: School Subjects

Belle loves learning and going to school. She knows how important it is to study if she wants to become a pilot.

Children from **C.I.** can repeat after you the name of the subjects, those from **C.M.** and **C.S.** can identify the names of the subjects.

Afterwards, children can play the game "**What's the school subject?**" This game can be played by dividing your class into two teams. You can choose a student to read the definitions aloud.

You can then have your students write on a plastic folder, for example, and the team that guesses correctly, and has no spelling mistakes, wins.

**Note:** for the school subjects that have no picture they can draw one that represents it. You can also ask them what their favourite school subject is and why.

This song presents the characters of the play and what they like. Listen to the song and learn it with your students. Fill in the gaps.

This exercise is for all ages.

For C.I. you can dictate the words and for all others they can use a dictionary if needed. At the beginning of the play we see Maurice doing a crossword and Belle helping him. This is a copy of Maurice's crossword so that your children familiarise themselves with the vocabulary used in the play.

## Worksheet 6: Hollywood & Studios Exercise For C.M & C.S.

Maurice gets lost in the Hollywood Hills. Where is Hollywood? Locate Hollywood by using the map. What is Hollywood? Ask your students to look for information on studios like Disney, Universal and Paramount. In three columns ask them to name and write the most famous movies that each studio has done.

What previous versions of Beauty and the Beast have been done?

Which other classic tales have been converted into movies?

Give web references for them to look for this information.

## Worksheet 7: Gold Song

Ursula likes materialistic things: diamonds, gold, selfies and social media. Listen to the song, learn it and fill in the gaps.

**Key: 1-Something, 2-selfie, 3-gold, 4-silver, 5-diamonds, 6-flowers, 7-jewels, 8-mountains, 9-chocolates.**

## Worksheet 8: Alone Song: Comparatives And Vocabulary Exercise

Belle is left alone in the Beast's mansion. She remembers her dad and everything he taught her, which helps her to be strong at this difficult moment.

**Students from C.I. can sing along to the song.**

**C.M. & C.S.:** Listen to the song and teach the vocabulary, especially comparative forms. Make them look for the adjective, eg: The adjective of colder is COLD. Ask the students to create new sentences with those comparatives using X is + adjective + er than Y.

Example sentence: January is colder than December.

Sing along and learn the song with all your students. Students from **C.M. & C.S.** can fill in the gaps.

## Worksheet 9.1: Aviator's Famous Chart

## Post Show Exercises:

**Reading comprehension exercise post show with the song:**

-What does she like now?

-What does "judge a book by it's cover" mean?

-Do you have similar idioms in your language?

## **Worksheet 11: Post Show Exercise. Guided Debate.**

Use the song to generate an informed and guided debate amongst your students about bullying.

I agree



I disagree


Read one statement in loud voice and ask your students to go to their chosen corner. Ask the children of each corner why they have chosen that option. Invite your children to be able to change the corner after listening to others' reasons. Repeat the process with all the statements. Create a little debate about it. Was there something surprising in this activity? Why do you believe people have different opinions about these statements? Have you ever changed your opinion? What was the reason for changing your opinion? How do we know what is the correct answer?


### Down:
