


little red Rocks



SYNOPSIS:

Little Red is a bright and clever young girl who lives with her dad, Thomas Red. One day Thomas receives a letter: Barbara, his mum, an old star of the music world is in danger of losing her house unless she submits a document that Thomas has. However, he can not go and give it to her as he needs to work at the hospital. Little Red is very brave and offers to help her grandmother. Little Red will travel a long distance to carry the document all the way from Barcelona to London. On her journey, she carries the "Book of The Best in You" where she writes the best of people's characters and the good things people do for others. Little Red wants to become a journalist and wants to write only about good things and good news. On Little Red's trip she meets many different characters, including greedy Mr. Wolf who tries to trick her and steal her precious book and her Grandmother's important document; crazy Mexican hostess, Lupita, who teaches Little Red that flying can be fun; a Russian perfumer, Olenka, who will give Little Red a magic perfume and help her to find the correct way to her grandmother's house, when she gets lost.

Worksheet 1: Flashcards of the main characters of the play

Characters: Little Red, Granny: Barbara Shine, Mr. Wolf.

The aim of the exercise is to learn the names and be familiar with the characters of the play. Use the Flashcards to introduce the characters and get familiar with the vocabulary of the play.

Worksheet 2: Reading Comprehension Exercise

Match each character with the description given.

Worksheet 3:

This drawing shows the trip Little Red takes to get to her destination, her grandmother's house, and all the people and danger she will encounter. Thomas is afraid of many things because Little Red: Travels alone, travels by plane, can get lost, can get sick and London is a big city.

C.I.: Ask the CI students to colour the nautical chart.

C.M. & C.S.: Ask your students to create sentences with the dangers of the trip.

Worksheet 3.1. Plan your own route:

Ask your students of **C.M. & C.S.** to create their own nautical chart (as if they were in a ship that is sailing to its destination). What is your objective? Draw your own path to an objective: write down and draw the things you can find on the way, good and bad, strengths and weaknesses of yourself to get to the objective you want. For example: become a vet, go on the school's ski trip, whatever things they really want.

Worksheet 4: 01: OPENING - MY BOOK OF THE BEST IN YOU:

Introducing Little Red and Thomas Red and the Book of The Best in You.

The Book of The Best in You: a notebook where Little Red writes all the good things about people and the good things people do.

Vocabulary: Find the bold words in the song and write down the word under each drawing.

Vocabulary: Crossword of The Best in You: How can you be the Best in You? Find the words of the song in the word search: Love, Proud, Take Care, Kind, Sing, Happy, Say, Share.

Extra C.S.: Ask your students to write down two or three positive adjectives to describe three classmates such as: kind, nice, brave, adaptable, adventurous, sincere, sensible, reliable, persistent, inventive, generous, passionate, considerate, frank, etc... Have them look-up the words to find the adjectives that best suit the character of their friends. They can all read the sentences aloud to the class.



Worksheet 5: 02: FEEL THE DIFFERENCE:

We live in a world with loads of differences, many cultures and languages. What's the problem? Our differences make us unique. In this song Little Red is going to give us examples of differences and explain that differences make each one of us unique and precious.

Vocabulary: Listen to the song and fill the gaps of the missing words:

Hair, eyes, smiles, languages, differences, world, unique, things, different, difference
We are going to ask your students: Who is unique? Raise your hand!



Worksheet 6: 03: FLY WITH ME:

Lupita is a crazy air hostess that will make us enjoy our flight and not be afraid, with her crazy easy going song. Sing along and learn the vocabulary of the song.



Worksheet 7: 04: IT SMELLS LIKE HOME:

Little Red is going to meet Olenka, a Russian perfumist that will help her find the way to her grandmother's house. But first Olenka will sing her a song with a trick she has to make a perfume that smells like her home, back in Russia. Olenka is going to give Little Red a magic perfume and she is going to teach children the smells of different things asking some to come on stage.

7.1 Listen to the song, sing along and learn the vocabulary.

7.2 Vocabulary exercise: Ask your children to write down the name of each smell using the words in the box.

Worksheet 8: 05: I WANT IT ALL:

With this song we get to know Mr. Wolf and what he wants. He is really greedy and wants it all for himself. Listen to the song and use the drawings to learn the vocabulary related to routines, hours and meals and types of transport.

Worksheet 9: 06: THE ZIP ZAP SONG:

Barbara is a great singer and she used to be a music star. Listen to her most famous song and sing with her while learning vocabulary of body parts, actions, instruments and music-related vocabulary. Match the bold word with its drawing.


Worksheet 10: 07: FINALE:

Your students can choose the ending! Once we get to the end of the story we can look back at the things we've learnt. Little Red helps her grandmother, writes about the story and makes her happy and famous again. Mr. Wolf discovers what he really likes to do in life and realises that is better than any money or possessions and best of it all, he can share it! Ask your students of **C.M.** & **C.S.** to make sentences with the bold words of the song. What does sharing is the key mean? What has each character learned? Ask them to do create a composition describing what they have seen.

Extra for C.S.: You are in the news! Little Red wants to be a journalist. To help children learn how it feels to be a journalist ask them to create their own newspaper front page. It can be a front page about themselves or others: ask them to include a photo they like, invent an article and a subtitle to explain a recent story of themselves or others, they might interview or be interviewed by a classmate and write the questions and answers.
